Facing the ancient and virtually untouched Lycian Rock tombs, Dalyan is an area of unequalled natural beauty. A peaceful river flows sedately through the town, past a backdrop of pine-clad mountains, through to the sea where a beautiful sandy beach sits, home to the endangered Loggerhead Turtle.
